If your child would like to bring Valentine's Day Cards for the class, please send them to school **in alphabetical order** (by first name) held together securely with an elastic or in a small ziploc bag. This will really help with the distribution of the cards. Thank you for your help with this! Please note that this is **optional** and there is no need to make or buy cards.

Creating Valentine's Day Cards is a great way for children to practice printing and literacy skills. They usually enjoy reading and writing their friends' names. Some students may just want to write the first letter of their classmates' names and you could write the remaining letters. Alternately, your child could cut the names from this page and glue them to cards or leave the "to" blank and just write their own name on each card. You may want to work on the cards over several days so your child doesn't grow too tired!

In French, we say "À" for "To" and "De" for "From".
